PIP team met today. We reviewed measures and goals. The entire team feels we should have no development of avoidable pressure ulcers. The team will be meeting weekly to discuss progress. A new skin assessment form was developed and placed in all nursing admission packets to be completed by nursing staff. An inservice has been scheduled next week for all nurses to review the new skin assessment form. Nurses will be instructed to complete the initial assessment for and initiate the preventative skin care plan of care within 24 hours of admission. Beginning 10/1/13, all residents on the West 100 Hallway (Rooms 100-125) identified with a pressure ulcer will be reviewed using the Pressure Ulcer Critical Element Pathway to determine avoidability.
